PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 448, 355 and 504 (i) of I.P.C., in Crime No.90 of 2010 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The submissions made by Mr.G.R.Swaminathan, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and by Mr.P.Rajendran, learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) representing the respondent police were heard.

3.Considering the fact that the dispute between the parties is civil in nature and the pendency of the second appeal before this court and also considering the nature of the allegations raised in the petition, this court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of their arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Utthamapalayam, Theni District and on each of them executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required. The petitioners shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

4.The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
