COMMON ORDER: - (Per Hon'ble Sri Justice A.Gopal Reddy)

These two writ petitions are filed by the mothers of the alleged

detenus-Mohd.Dastagir @ Sahil and Syed Sayeed Hussain alleging

that they are illegally detained by the respondents from the midnight of

06.05.2010 and are in their illegal custody.

The Inspector of Police, Madhapur Police Station, Secunderabad

filed a counter-affidavit stating that the alleged detenus were arrested by

the police of Sanjeevreddy Nagar on 27.05.2010 at 00:30 hours in

connection with crime No.589 of 2010 under Section 353 read with

Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 (1) (A) (3) of Indian

Arms Act and were produced before III Additional Chief Metropolitan

Magistrate, Nampally, Hyderabad on the same day and the learned

Magistrate remanded them to judicial custody. Pursuant to the remand

order, they were lodged at Central Prison, Cherlapally, Rangareddy

District.

Since the crime has already been registered against the alleged

detenus, who were produced before the Magistrate and were remanded

to judicial custody under a lawful order passed by the Magistrate, the

illegal detention as alleged by the petitioners does not arise.

Accordingly, the writ petitions are dismissed. No costs.
