CRIMINAL PETITION No.10750 OF 2009

ORDER:

This Criminal Petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is filed by the petitioners, accused Nos.1 to 13, seeking to quash the proceedings against them in Crime No.1028 of 2009 of Banjara Hills Police Station, Hyderabad, registered for the offences under Sections 147, 448, 427, 506 read with 149 IPC.

2. Heard.

3. The contention of the learned counsel for the petitioners is that the impugned complaint is a false one.

4. In view of the nature of allegations, which involve questions

of fact, investigation cannot be stopped and therefore the petition is not maintainable.

5. In the circumstances, it is directed that investigation and consequential steps on the basis of result of the investigation shall go on. However, the petitioners shall not be called to any Police Station and the Court till filing of charge sheet, if any. The petitioners are at liberty to challenge the charge sheet, if any filed.

6. With the above directions, the Criminal Petition is dismissed at the admission stage itself.
