The Court made the following:

ORDER:

This writ petition is filed for the following substantive relief:
"To issue a writ of Mandamus, declaring the inaction of

the respondent in not following the principle laid down in the Government Memo No.623/SPL.C/2008-2, dated 15.10.2008 issued by the Government of Andhra Pradesh and also the inaction of the second respondent in not preparing and filing the draft charge sheet in C.C.No.7 of 2009 on the file of the III Additional District and Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge for ACB Cases, Visakhapatnam, as per the principles laid down in the said Government Memo as illegal, arbitrary and violative of Article 14 of the constitution of India and consequently, direct the second respondent to file the revised charge sheet in the said C.C. by applying the principle laid down in the said memo.”

At the hearing, Sri M.Karuna Sagar, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that his client seeks to withdraw the writ petition.

In view of this submission, the writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

As a sequel to dismissal of the writ petition, W.P.M.P.No.3390 of 2010 is disposed of as infructuous. There shall be no order as to costs.
