Order:

This Writ Petition is filed for the following substantive relief:

“to issue an order, direction or writ, more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus declaring that the inaction of respondents No.2 & 3 in not taking any action in criminal law and departmentally against the fourth respondent for the offences of extortion, intimidation, and torture committed upon the petitioner while in charge of the first respondent- police station, leading to the petitioner's attempt to commit suicide on 27.11.2003, in spite of detailed complaints submitted to them, as unlawful and unconscionable dereliction of duty, and further direct the said respondents to take action against the fourth respondent in accordance with law.”

Ms.Vasudha Nagaraj, learned Counsel, who has put up appearance in the Court as the office colleague of late K.Balagopal, submitted that she has no instructions from the petitioner.

In view of the same, the Writ Petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.

As a sequel to dismissal of the Writ Petition, WPMP.No.23300 of 2006, filed by the petitioner for interim relief, is disposed of as infructuous.
