Present petition is filed challenging the order dated 04.09.2010 passed by learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Dera Bassi, whereby an adjournment sought by the plaintiff – petitioner was refused and evidence of the plaintiff was directed to be closed and case was directed to be listed for defendants' evidence on 23.10.2010.

Learned senior counsel for the plaintiff – petitioner, assisted by Mr. Rajwant Singh Chahal, Advocate, states that on the date as fixed by this Court or by the learned Trial Court, entire remaining evidence shall be produced before the learned Trial Court and no adjournment shall be sought.

In the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case, keeping in mind, the golden rule that none should be given walk over and lis between the parties, as far as possible, should be decided on merit after giving sufficient opportunities to both the parties to place on record entire evidence and material, I direct that learned Trial Court shall fix any date for the purpose of plaintiff's evidence and on the date so fixed by the learned Trial Court, petitioner shall produce all the witnesses before the Court. If, for any reason, examination is not complete on the date so fixed, then learned Trial Court shall be at liberty to hold day-to-day trial or fix any future date, which is convenient to the Court. Plaintiff – petitioner shall pay Rs. 5000/- as costs to the defendants.

Petition shall stand disposed of accordingly.
