SABINA, J.

Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.61 dated 3.7.2010, under Sections 436,452,324,323,427,148,149 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Gate Hakiman, District Amritsar.

At the time of issuance of notice of motion on 1.10.2010, the following order was passed by this Court :-

"Notice of motion for 13.10.2010.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioners be admitted to interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. They shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

List alongwith CRM-M- No.26438 of 2010.”

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by Sub Inspector Harbhajan Singh, has submitted that in terms of the above order the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court on 1.10.2010 is made absolute.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
