This petition is filed by the petitioner seeking protection to their life and liberty which is allegedly threatened by respondent Nos. 4 to 8 on account of the marriage against their wishes. Petitioner No.1 was born on 08.08.1970 , as per Annexure P-1, whereas petitioner No.2 was born on 30.6.1983, as per Annexure P-2. They both have got married on 27.12.2010 as per Annexure P-3. Photographs of their marriage are also attached. It is alleged that earlier petitioner No.1 was married to Jagjit Singh son of Sukhwinder Singh but their marriage was dissolved by order of the Court passed in H.M.A. Case No.47 of 2006 decided on 22.1.2007 (Annexure P-7). Petitioner No.1 has also sworn an affidavit dated 30.12.2010 in which she has alleged that against the order of divorce (Annexure P-7), no appeal is pending. Moreover, her erstwhile husband, Jagjit Singh, has already got remarried in the year 2008. Petitioners have also made a complaint/representation to the Senior Superintendent of Police,Ambala City (respondent No.2 before filing the present petition.

After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioners and keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to look into the

complaint/representation (Annexure P-5) and inquire into the same either himself or through someone to be deputed by him, and in case any truth is found in the complaint/representation (Annexure P-5), then adequate police protection be provided to the petitioners to save their life and liberty at the hands of respondent Nos. 3 to 8. Respondent No.2 is also free to call the parties, if so requires, for an amicable settlement.
