The petitioners are stated to be major having married contrary
to the wishes of their parents.

It is contended by the learned counsel for the petitioners that
there is an apprehension that life and liberty of the petitioners will be
prejudiced at the instance of private respondents.

Before coming to this Court, the petitioners had filed an
application (Annexure P-5) to the Superintendent of Police, Faridkot
(respondent No. 2.).

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2
to look into this matter either himself or through any other officer deputed
by him and in case any truth is found in the representation (Annexure P-5),
he will ensure the protection of life and liberty of the petitioners. It is
further directed that respondent No. 2, if so requires, can even call the
parties for an amicable settlement.
