**AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)**

The petitioners submit that they are apprehending danger to their life and liberty from Sarwan Singh-respondent No. 4, Gurmeet Kaur-respondent No. 5 and Sampuran Singh-respondent No. 6 and for putting forth that grievance, they have moved a representation to the Superintendent of Police, Ambala, highlighting therein their grievance and their apprehension. The said representation is dated 27.12.2010 (Annexure P-4). Counsel prays that a direction be issued to the respondents No. 2 and 3 to look into the representation dated 27.12.2010 (Annexure P-4) and take necessary steps in accordance with law.

Without going into the merits of the case and without commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to

the Superintendent of Police, Ambala-respondent No. 2 and Station House Officer, Police Station, Baldev Camp, District Ambala-respondent No. 3, to look into the representation dated 27.12.2010 (Annexure P-4) preferred by the petitioners and if some substance is found therein, necessary steps, in accordance with law, be taken thereon.

Petition stands disposed of.
