The petitioners submit that they are apprehending danger to their life and liberty from Ishaq Ali-respondent No. 4, Rehana-respondent No. 5, Kallu-respondent No. 6, Naushad-respondent No. 7 and Sony-respondent No. 8 and for putting forth that grievance, they have moved a representation to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, highlighting therein their grievance and their apprehension. The said representation is dated 29.12.2010 (Annexure P-5). Counsel prays that a direction be issued to respondents No. 1 to 3 to look into the representation dated 29.12.2010 (Annexure P-5) and take necessary steps in accordance with law.

Without going into the merits of the case and without commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to

the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur-respondent No. 2 and S.H.O. Police Station, Sangrur-respondent No. 3 to look into the representation dated 29.12.2010 (Annexure P-5) preferred by the petitioners and if some substance is found therein, necessary steps, in accordance with law, be taken thereon.

Petition stands disposed of.
