## **ORDER:**

- 1. This petition seeks quashing of order dated 13.1.2010, whereby the Food Corporation of India has given the contract of handling of transport work to respondent No.2.
- 2. Grievance of the petitioner is that only a registered union could be given the contract, while the union of which respondent No.2 was the President, was not registered.
- 3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though respondent No.2 applied in his personal capacity, vide resolution, Annexure P-10, it was the union which had authorized him to apply for the tender.
- 4. It is not disputed that individually, respondent No.2 was eligible to get the contract and whether he was acting as a proxy for the union or not, is a question of fact. Having regard to

the facts of this case, it will not be appropriate to adjudicate upon this question in summary jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution.

- 5. The petition is dismissed.
- 6. It is made clear that this will not debar any other remedy to the petitioner in accordance with law.
