SURYA KANT, J. [ORAL]

The petitioner claims Death-cum-Retirement benefits in respect of her deceased sister -Raghbir Kaur, who was working as a Staff Nurse under the Senior Medical Officer at CHC, Tibba, District Kapurthala and has unfortunately expired on 17.9.2008 while in service.

Though, the petitioner is married, however, her claim appears to be that she continued to depend upon her sister during her life time as she was an earning hand. If that is so, the petitioner may submit a supplementary representation to the authorities concerned along with necessary documents.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of with a direction to respondents that as and when such a representation is made, the Competent Authority shall consider and dispose of the same, in accordance with law expeditiously and by passing a speaking order, within three months from the date a certified copy of this order is received.
