Applicant Doongar Singh Darmyal, who is in jail in connection with Crime No. 10 of 2009, relating to offences punishable under Section 7, 13(1)(d) read with Section 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, police station Vigilance Sector, District Dehradun, has sought his release on bail.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The first bail application was rejected, as not pressed on 13.04.2010, by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Dharam Veer (since expired).

Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that applicant is in jail for last more than one year. It is submitted that amount said to have been received by the applicant as bribe was ₹ 3,000/-. It is further pointed out that the trial is still at the stage of beginning.

In the above circumstances, without expressing any opinion as to the final merits of the case, this court is of the view that now, the applicant deserves bail.

The second bail application is allowed. Let the applicant Doongar Singh Darmyal be released on bail on his executing a personal bond and furnishing two sureties, each of the like amount, to the satisfaction of court concerned.
