Heard Mr. Shivanand Bhatt, Advocate for the petitioner and Mr. K.C. Tiwari, learned Brief Holder on behalf of the respondent.

By means of this petition the petitioner has sought a order or direction to take immediate steps for demarcation of petitioner's property depicted by Khasra No. 260D, 617 total measuring 0.4050 hectare situated at Mauza Charba Pargana Pachwadoon, District Dehradun, as expeditiously as possible or within such time as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.

During the course of argument learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that petitioner society purchased a property depicted by Khasra No.1347, and the name of petitioner was recorded in revenue records but during the process of Bandobast Khasra No. 1347 was changed to Khasra Nos. 260D and 617. The petitioner is in possession of Khasra No. 260D but the other Khasra No. 617 has wrongly been shown from the said land of petitioner. Boundary of the land has also been destroyed during rainy season of 2006 and nearby property holders wanted to grab the property. With this apprehension petitioner has filed petition before the Sub Divisional Officer Vikasnagar Dehradun which is still pending. Therefore, the Sub Divisional Officer/ Assistant Collector, Vikasnagar, Dehradun, be

directed to decide the application of the petitioner as expeditiously as possible.

In view of above, the Sub Divisional Officer/Assistant Collector, Vikasnagar, District Dehradun, is directed to decide the application of the petitioner, if the same is pending for disposal before him, in accordance with law, within a period of six months from the date of production of certified copy of this order.

With the above direction, the writ petition is disposed of finally.
