By means of this petition the petitioner has sought a writ

in the nature of mandamus, directing and commanding the

respondents to issue the Jatav Caste (S.C.) certificate to the petitioner

without any technical objection.

During the course of argument learned counsel for the

petitioner has submitted that the petitioner and his family are the

permanent resident of village Sakeniya, P.O. Subhashnagar, Tehsil

Gadarpur, District Udham Singh Nagar. He urged that Tehsildar

Gadarpur/respondent No.3 is raising objection in issuing the caste

certificate on the ground that record of permanent residence of 40

years be produced, whereas the same is not required as per G.O. dated

28-05-2010, wherein 15 years period of permanent residence in

Uttarakhand State is provided. Learned counsel, therefore, submitted

that the Tehsildar concerned be directed to take a decision on the

application of the petitioner at the earliest. Prayer made is innocuous.

The Tehsildar Gadarpur/respondent No.3 is directed to

take a decision on the application of the petitioner for issue of caste

certificate, which is pending before him, in accordance with law/G.O.,

within a period of two weeks from the date of production of certified

copy of this order.

With the aforesaid direction the writ petition is disposed

of finally.
