Mitra and holds a Sahityaratna Degree from

Hindi Sahitya Sammelan, Prayag, which is

degree equivalent to а graduate

consequently, entitled to be considered for the

aforesaid B.T.C. training course.

Having considered the matter the writ

petition is disposed of with a direction to the

petitioner to file an appropriate representation

alongwith a certified copy of this order before

the authority concerned. If the petitioner

moves such a representation, the authority will

decide the representation of the petitioner by a

reasoned and speaking order within two weeks

from the date of the production of a certified

copy of this order.
