The learned counsel for the petitioner alleges that the respondents invited applications for two years B.T.C. training in which the eligibility criteria was that the candidate should be a graduate and should also be a Shiksha Mitra. The petitioner contends that she is working as a Shiksha Mitra and holds a Sahityaratna Degree from Hindi Sahitya Sammelan, Prayag, which is equivalent to a graduate degree and consequently, entitled to be considered for the aforesaid B.T.C. training course.

Having considered the matter the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to file an appropriate representation alongwith a certified copy of this order before the authority concerned. If the petitioner moves such a representation, the authority will decide the representation of the petitioner by a reasoned and speaking order within two weeks from the date of the production of a certified copy of this order.
