This order governs the disposal of second bail application filed under Section 439 of Cr. P. C. by Shri Mahendra Shandilya, Advocate on behalf of the applicant Jagdish Bisht pertaining to F. I. R. No. 62/2009 of police station Chambaji, Jai pur, in the offences under Sections 420, 467, 471 and 120-B of IPC.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as also learned Public Prosecutor for the State and perused the material on record.

3. Learned Public Prosecutor appearing for the State has opposed the bail petition.

Having considered the submissions made at the bar and perused the relevant material available on record including the first bail order dated 7th September, 2009, it is made clear that earlier also the arguments were advanced at length and the first bail order dated 7th September, 2009 was also recorded in detail, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the

case, do not find any good ground to change my earlier view and his second bail petition deserves to be dismissed for those very reasons as enumerated in first Bail Order dated 7.9.2009.

5. In the result, the second bail petition filed under Section 439 of Cr. P. C. on behalf of the accused-petitioner Jagdish Bisht S/o Shri Manphool Singh stands dismissed.
