BY THE COURT:

It is stated that it is a case of bail jump for a period of less than ten months. Petitioner will regularly attend the trial court in future thus he may be granted bail.

After considering submissions made at the Bar, without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, which may otherwise affect outcome of the trial, looking to the facts of this case, I am of the view that petitioner deserves to be enlarged on bail.

Accordingly, the bail application is accepted and it is directed that accused-petitioner namely; Jitendra Budhanian may be enlarged on bail under section 439 CrPC in FIR No. 57/2007 registered at Police Station – Neem Ka Thana, Sikar for offence under Section/s 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC and section 3

(i)(iv) of the SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, provided, he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.40,000/- together with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of learned trial Court for his appearance before that Court on all subsequent dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so. Petitioner is however, directed to attend the trial court regularly.
