Heard learned counsel for the accused-petitioner, learned counsel for the complainant-JVVNL as well as learned Public Prosecutor for the State and also perused the record.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that this Court has in S.B. Criminal Miscellaneous Bail Application No.10468 of 2010 {Pooran Mal & Another Vs. State} granted bail to the co-accused vide order dated 12/11/2010 and the case of the petitioner, it is submitted by the learned counsel is on better footings, as only his motor-cycle is said to have been involved in the incident involving a theft and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I deem it just and proper to enlarge the accused-petitioner namely; Mahesh Solanki son of Shri Murari Lal by case Solanki, resident of Pai Gate, Malakheda District Alwar on bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in F.I.R. No.316/2010 registered at Police Station Malakheda, Alwar during the pendency of the trial on his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand Only) with two sureties in the sum of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Judge for his appearance before the trial Court as and when called upon to do

The bail application is accordingly disposed of.
