Petitioner    is    apprehending    his  
arrest    in    a    case    registered    under    Section  
302/34    of    the    Indian    Penal    Code    and    Section  
27    of    the    Arms    Act.

It    is    alleged    in    the    F.I.R.    that  
Dilshad Khan and Farid Khan were obstructed  
by    the    co-villagers    while    they    were  
disturbing the dancers then they made threat  
and    subsequently    on    11.06.2010    during  
marriage ceremony at 11:30p.m. Dilshad Khan,  
Sonu Khan, Absrar Khan and Istiyat Ali came  
on two motorcycles and made indiscriminate  
firing causing death to Bhual Singh Yadav,  
brother of the informant. The name of the  
petitioner sprang up on confession of the  
co-accused Dilshad khan to be the one of the  
associates of the assailants.

Since in the F.I.R. there is specific  
accusation of firing against four persons  
and the F.I.R. does not suggest the presence

of any other person except the four F.I.R. named accused persons, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kaimur (Bhabua) in connection with Mohania P.S. Case No. 185 of 2010, subject to conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Indian Penal Code.
