counsel for the State.

The allegation is that in spite of prohibitory order the staff of the petitioner was dealing in wine. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a licensee and on the day of occurrence no sale of illicit liquor was being carried out. The staff of the petitioner was simply doing some accounts work inside the shop. It is also submitted that from the first information report it would appear that prohibitory order was effective from 21.10.2010 and raid was conducted on 20.10.2010.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid submissions, let the petitioner, namely, Rabindra Kumar Yadav in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from the date of communication of the order be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.5,000/- (five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Purnea in connection with Sadar (Dagarua) P.S. Case No.350 of 2010.
