The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered under Sections 414 of the I.P.C., 7 of the E.C. Act, 23 of the Petroleum Act and 43 of Natural Gas regulatory Act.

It is alleged that near the restaurant of the petitioner from a hut huge quantity of petrol and diesel as well as 43 empty gas cylinders were recovered.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the empty gas cylinders were directed to be released in favor of the villagers. It is further submitted that the case has been investigated by the police officer who is not authorize to investigate the case. Moreover, the seizure list suggests that the seizure has not been made from the petitioner's portion of the area.

Considering the aforesaid facts let, the petitioner, namely, Pritam Mishra, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Khagaria in connection with Pasraha P.S. Case No. 67 of 2010.
