Petitioner is named though by the victim girl in her statement under section 164 Cr.P.C. but he has been shown in company of Sukani Devi, Sita Devi and Urmila Devi, of them co-accused Sukani Devi asked her to come to a fair. They boarded a train and went to different places, lastly she married one Saroj Yadav, if that can be taken kidnapping then its purpose lacking and petitioner is least concern with the occurrence.

Thus, having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Sessions Judge, F.T.C. I, Katihar in Barari P.S. Case No. 88/2009.
