Petitioners being mother and unmarried sister of the husband are apprehending heir arrest in a case registered under Sections 304B, 498A, 120B, 201 of the I.P.C.

It is alleged that the marriage was performed two years prior to the occurrence. It is claimed by the informant that he received information that his daughter has been poisoned and when he reached he found the dead body of his daughter in a banana orchard. He took the photograph of the dead body also.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the informant does not talk about any injury to the victim even the resisting injury.

Considering the fact that no injury was found on the body of the victim by the informant and petitioners being female, let the petitioners namely 1. Indu Devi 2. Guddi Kumari, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of

Chief Judicial Magistrate, Begusarai in connection with G.R. No. 2958 of 2010 arising out of Matihani P.S. Case No. 104 of 2010.

It is undertaken by learned counsel for the petitioner that the husband will surrender within a period of two weeks.

Let the bail bond of the petitioners be accepted on surrender of the husband.
