The petitioner is an accused in a case under Sections 25 (1-B) A/26 of the Arms Act. In connection with the case, he is in custody since 09.12.2010.

One country made pistol with one misfired cartridge was recovered from the possession of the petitioner.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is accused in two cases of the years 1996 and 2001 and he does not have any recent criminal antecedents.

Considering all facts, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail in Chiraya Police Station Case No. 229 of 2010 on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sikarahnna at Motihari subject to the following conditions.

(a). One of the bailors should be closely related to the petitioner;

(b). The attested copies of the photographs of the bailors must be affixed on the bail bonds; &

(c). The petitioner shall remain physically present before the Court below on each and every date as and when required by it and his absence even for a single date without any explanation to the satisfaction of the Court below, will result in the cancellation of the bail bonds.
