Heard Mr. Ajay Kumar Thakur, learned counsel for
the petitioner and learned APP for the State.

The petitioner is the sole named accused of the
case registered under sections 25(1-B)A, 26 of the Arms Act on
the allegation that on 28th June, 2011 he was found in
possession of a bag from which three country made pistols were
recovered.

Submission is that the pistols were recovered
without any cartridges and the petitioner is a man of advance
age of 60 years which is apparent from the annexure-2 the
voter identity card which has been issued by the Election
Commission of India. In paragraph 12 of the petitioner it has
been mentioned that this is the first case in which the

petitioner has been made accused.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner above named is directed to be released on furnishing of bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned S.D.J.M./concerned Court, Masaurhi in connection with Masaurhi P.S. Case No. 258 of 2011.
