

Petitioner is an accused in a case registered for the offence under Sections 379 and 411 of the Indian Penal Code in connection with theft of a tractor, which was recovered from the house of Bilasi Singh, but petitioner has been arrested while he was coming out of Cinema Hall in the town of Sitamarhi and is said to be involved in the theft of said tractor. From paragraph 12 of the petition itself, it appears that petitioner is accused in two cases, one registered for the offence under Section 379 and other under Section 401 of the Indian Penal Code.

In view of the antecedent of the petitioner, I am not inclined to release him on bail. This application is rejected. He may, however, renew his prayer for bail after completing nine months in jail custody.
