Heard Counsel for the petitioner and the A.P.P. appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is an accused in a case under Sections 147, 148, 149, 302 of the Indian Penal Code, Section 27 of the Arms Act and Section 17 of the Criminal Law Amendment Act. In connection with the case, he is in custody since 22.11.2010.

It is alleged that Jatu Yadav, Chanarik Yadav, Rajenmdra Yadav and Bisheswar Yadav caught hold the brother of the informant, whereas Brahmdeo Yadav, Toofani Singh and Mani Yadav fired with the sten-gun. The petitioner is a member of the mob.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that Kameshwar Yadav @ Lambu Yadav and Jatu Yadav have been granted bail by this Court vide orders dated 21.05.2007 and 24.08.2009 passed in Criminal Misc. Nos. 17056 of 2007 and 30571of 2009 respectively.

Considering the facts aforesaid, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail in Gurua Police Station Case No. 31 of 1999 on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.

10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sherghati, Gaya subject to the following conditions.

- (a). One of the bailors should be closely related to the petitioner;
- (b). The attested copies of the photographs of the bailors must be affixed on the bail bonds; &
- (c). The petitioner shall remain physically present before the Court below on each and every date as and when required by it and his absence even for a single date without any explanation to the satisfaction of the Court below, will result in the cancellation of the bail bonds.
