Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned

counsel appearing for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with a case registered for the offence under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 324, 307, 504 and 379 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is stated that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. Md. Alamgir a co-accused, who was supporting the wife of petitioner in Panchayat election, had also filed a case against the accused Nasara Jabi and her husband as well as her other relatives who assaulted mercilessly Md. Alamgir and others. While co-accused Md. Alamgir was admitted in Sub-divisional hospital, Dalsingsarai for treatment, the husband of Nasara Jabi, namely, Ansar Ahmad with the help of his supporter Md. Zahangir and and Mahmood instituted the present case. Co-accused Alamgir has received five injuries out of which injury no. 1 is grievous in nature. The petitioner's wife was contesting for the post of Mukhia whereas Nasara Jabi was the sitting Mukhia of the Panchayat.

It is also submitted that co-accused Pankaj Kumar Roy @ Pankaj Roy, Kamleshwar Rai, Yogendra Rai, Rajendra Roy, Hira Lal Sahni, Mahendra Roy and Md. Alamgir had already been granted anticipatory bail by this Court in Cr. Misc. No. 20637 of

2011 by order dated 15.07.2011.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, namely Anil Rai @ Anil Kumar Rai in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/communication of this order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 5,000/- (Five thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Dalsingsarai, Samastipur in connection with Angarghat P.S. Case No. 28 of 2011 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.
