Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner being the husband is apprehending his arrest in a complaint case in which cognizance has been taken under Sections 498A, 323 and 379 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner is ready to keep the complainant as wife with full dignity and honour.

In the circumstances, let the above named petitioner, be released on provisional anticipatory bail for six months, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Subdivisional Judicial Magistrate, Samastipur in connection with Complaint Case No. 1192/2009, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section

438(2) Cr.P.C.

Let the learned court below issue notice to the complainant and on her appearance the petitioner will take the complainant to her matrimonial house to keep her as wife with full dignity and honour.

The provisional anticipatory bail of the petitioner will be confirmed by the learned court below on substantial restoration of the matrimonial harmony or the complainant deliberately refuses to reside with the petitioner.
