Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned counsel for the state.

Supplementary affidavit has been filed on behalf of the petitioner, ShriKant Yadav stating therein that the petitioner is aged about 70 years and he is suffering from paralytic attack.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he alongwith three other persons went at the house of the informant and committed the murder of informant's son and her daughter-in-law by opening indiscriminate firing. The reason behind this occurrence is said to be previous enmity as the daughter-in-law of the informant happens to be niece of the petitioner and she had solemnized her love marriage with the son of the informant. Although the informant has claimed to have identified the petitioner committing the alleged crime but she has specifically stated in her fardbeyan that all the miscreants were between age of 25-35 years and as per submission of learned counsel, the petitioner is aged about 70 years.

Therefore, taking into consideration the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as submission of the parties, let the petitioner, namely, ShriKant Yadav be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs 10,000/- (ten thousand)

with two sureties of the like amount each in connection with Goreyakothi G.B. Nagar P.S. Case No. 61 of 2010 to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Siwan.
