Heard learned counsels for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 341 and 452 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

The accusation is of entering into the house of the informant and making assault by petitioner no. 4 with the butt of the rifle.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that both sides are on litigating terms from before and the petitioner no.1 lodged a complaint against the informant and his brother.

Considering the fact that actually no substantial injury has been caused and the litigated terms between the parties from before, let the above

named petitioners, be released on anticipatory bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Sub-divisional Judicial Magistrate, Masaurhi, Patna in connection with Dhanarua P.S. Case No. 466/2010, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
