Petitioner being the son of the Mukhiya is apprehending his arrest in a case registered under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471/34 of the I.P.C.

It is alleged against the petitioner to have fraudulently withdrawn Rs. 8,000/- with regard to crop compensation scheme.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner has already deposited Rs. 8,000/-.

Let the petitioner deposit Rs. 10,000/- before the learned Court below which will be invested in some fixed deposit scheme. The aforesaid amount will be subject to the result of the case.

Considering the aforesaid fact, let the petitioner namely Ram Dayal Singh, on deposit of the aforesaid amount and in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Samastipur in connection with Rosera P.S.
