		Magistrate, East Sikkim, directing the owner, Hotel Kunga
		Delek, Rumtek DCC, Rumtek to demolish the hotel building
		within 3 (three) days from the date of the order, the building
		having found to be severely damaged due to the Earthquake
		that occurred on 18.09.2011 and was likely to fall causing
		danger to the persons living in neighbourhood or those passing
		by.
		2. The application, as per Mr. Anmole Prasad, learned
		Senior Advocate appearing for the petitioner, was necessitated
		on account of an order dated 01.09.2000 passed by the learned
		District Judge, Special Division-I I/C, Gangtok in Civil Suit No.
		40 of 1999, renumbered as Title Suit No. 08 of 2004, by which
		maintenance of status-quo in respect of the suit properties in
		dispute in the suit had been directed on being conceded to by
		both the sides. It is submitted that the building in question is
		one of such properties falling within the disputed premises
		involved in the Title Suit No. 08 of 2004.
		3. In the present case, we are not concerned with the
		merits of the disputes between the parties in respect of the suit
		properties, but limited only to the order dated 30.09.2011
		issued under Section 133 Cr.P.C. passed by the District
		Magistrate, East Sikkim. In consideration of this and the grave
		urgency involved in the matter, the application is taken up for
		disposal.
		4. Mr. B. Sharma, learne'd Senior Advocate appearing
	1	on behalf of the petitioners concedes to the facts contained in
		the notice under Section 133 Cr.P.C.

		5. In view of this position and in view of the imminent	
		threat posed by the damaged building, where the Hotel namely,	
		"Hotel Kunga Delek" is being run, the State-respondents shall	
		proceed with the demolition of the building. The State-	
		respondents would be the appropriate party to take up the work	
		as it is also one of the parties in the title suit pending in the	
		Court below and, it is a matter of record that the state-	
		respondent was impleaded as a party primarily on account of its	
		role in intervening in the dispute to ensure maintenance of law	
		and order.	
		6. It may be observed that this Order shall not in any	
		manner affect the order of status-quo dated 01.09.2000 passed	
		by the learned trial Court.	
		7. It is also made clear that any observations made in	
		this order shall not be construed as expression of any opinion on	
		the merits of the case. Needless to state that the parties to the	
		Title Suit are at liberty to approach the learned Trial Court in	
		view of the situation arising out of the aforesaid facts, if so	
		advised in the matter.	
		8. With the above observations, the application stands	
		disposed off.
