This application U/S 438 CrPC has been filed by the petitioner, namely, Sri Bhuban Deka, praying for anticipatory bail apprehending his arrest in connection with Raha PS Case No. 81 of 2011 under Sections 420/409 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner is a Junior Engin

eer under the Raha Development Block.

In the FIR, the only allegation is that instead of allowing the beneficiary to purchase the materials by himself, the President of Ranthali GP purchased the materials and handed over to the beneficiary. In other words, there is no specific allegation against the petitioner.

Hence, the bail prayer is accepted.

Accordingly, the Investigating Officer is directed to release the petitioner aforesaid, in connection with the aforesaid PS Case, on bail, on his furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10, 000/-, with one surety of the like amount subject to his satisfaction.

With the aforesaid directions, this Anticipatory Bail Application stands disposed of.
