WP(C) 5385/2009 BEFORE HON'BLE MR JUSTICE B.K. SHARMA

Heard Mr. SK Das, learned counsel for the petitioners as well as Mr. BK Sharma, learned SC, SWD. I have also heard Ms. B. Borah, learned counsel for the respond ent Nos. 8 and 9.

The matter relates to selection and appointment of Ananwadi Workder in Tarmatha Pachim Chuba Anganwadi centre. In the writ petition various allegations have been made in respect of selection of the respondent Nos. 8 and 9. In the counter affidavit filed by the CDPO only statement taken is that the petitioner could not do well in the interview. However, nothing has been stated what are the marks secured by the rival candidates.

In view of the above, the writ petition is disposed of directing the Director of Social Welfare, Assam to cause an enquiry through the District Social Welfare, Nalbari in respect of the allegation made by the petitioners and thereaf ter on the basis of the report to be furnished to pass an appropriate order in a ccordance with law. However, no adverse order shall be passed against the respondent Nos. 8 and 9 without giving them an opportunity of being heard.

Entire exercise shall be carried out as expeditiously as possible, but a t any rate, not later than 31.12.2011. Till then, interim order passed earlier s hall continue.
