Shri Vivke Sharma, P.L. for the State.</p> <p>From the record it appears that this appeal was filed through jail by the appellant assailing the order dated 17.1.97 by which he was convicted under Section 304-Part II IPC and sentenced to undergo RI for five years and to pay fine of Rs. 1000, in default of payment of fine to further undergo SI for three months. Record further shows that till date the bail has not been granted by this Court whereas the accused/appellant was arrested on 18.9.96. Record also shows that on 4.9.01, information was sought by this Court about the detention period of the accused/appellant and on 3.6.97 the accused/appellant was transferred from Jashpur jail to Raipur jail and the notice was also served to the appellant but yet no response was given by him.</p> <p>It seems that the appellant is not interested to prosecute the appeal.</p> <p>Accordingly the appeal is dismissed.</p> <p>The appellant is left free to file a suitable application for revival of the appeal if occasion arises.</p> | |
