**Per Sunil Kumar Sinha, J.:**

Heard on admission.

2. Shri A.N.Pandey, learned counsel for the petitioner submits  
that the candidature of the petitioner for admission to M.B.B.S.  
course has been rejected on the ground that the petitioner became  
over-age on the relevant date. He prays that the above decision of  
the authorities may be quashed and they may be directed to allot  
M.B.B.S. seat to the petitioner.



3. Shri Bhaduri takes us to the relevant rule, which says that a candidate must not be of more than 25 years on 31<sup>st</sup> of December of the year in which the admission is being sought.

4. The date of birth of the petitioner is 18-6-1986. According to which, he would be of more than 25 years on 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2011.

5. In view of the above factual scenario, we do not find any infirmity in the decision of rejecting the candidature of the petitioner on account of his age being more than 25 years on the relevant date.

6. The petition has no merit. The same is liable to be and is hereby dismissed summarily.
