1. Heard.
2. By way of this writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India the petitioner has prayed for a direction to the respondent No.2 to refer the matter of the petitioner to Respondent No.1 & 3 or any expert Committee of recognized institute for its opinion/clarification to the effect that degree of M.Sc. (Biotechnology) is equivalent to degree in M.Sc. (Zoology) and after receipt of expert's report/opinion, consider candidature of the petitioner for the post of Assistant Professor (Zoology).
3. This Court vide order dated 27.07.2011 has disposed of bunch of writ petitions, leading case of which was W.P. (S) No.5770/10 (Devendra Kumar Mishra & another Vs. State of C.G. & others), and the prayer sought in the instant writ petition is also of similar nature, which has not been disputed by learned counsel appearing for the respondents.
4. Accordingly, we dispose of this writ petition in terms of the order dated 27.7.2011 passed by this Court in W.P.(S) No. 5770/10 with a direction that directions issued therein shall be applicable *mutatis mutandis* in the instant writ petition also.
