Learned counsel submits that aggrieved by the selection, representation has been given to the Collector, who is also appellate authority under the Chhattisgarh Panchayat Shiksha Karmi (Recruitment and Conditions of Services) Rules, 2007, but the Collector has not taken any decision on his representation.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the State submits that the representation which has been filed by the petitioner before the Collector shall be duly considered and decision thereon shall be taken.</p> <p>In view of the submission made by learned counsel for the State, this petition is finally disposed off.</p> <p>Collector-respondent No.2 shall decide the representation of the petitioner expeditiously without undue delay.</p> <p>In view of above, I.A.No.1, I.A.No.2 and I.A.No.3 stand disposed off</p> | |
