With the consent of learned counsel for the parties, the matter is heard finally.

The petitioners were appointed on a fixed pay of Rs.150/-. After successfully completing the probation period of 2 years, they were granted regular pay scale.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that the issue involved in the case is as to whether, the petitioners are entitled to regular pay scale with effect from the date of initial appointment or after completion of probation period.

The issue involved herein was considered by the Madhya Pradesh State Administrative Tribunal, Jabaipur in O A.No.2745/89 (Madhukant Yadu and 56 others v. State of M.P. & others), wherein, it was held that the similarly situated teachers are entitled to regular pay scale with effect from the date of initial appointment. The matter was taken up to the Hon'ble Supreme Court in special Leave Petition (Civil) No.6892/93. The said petition was dismissed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, upholding the decision of the Tribunal to the effect that the Teachers/Assistant Teachers are entitled to regular pay scale from the date of initial appointment.

Accordingly, the petitioners are granted liberty to make a representation raising all their grievances, in the light of the aforesaid judgment and circular dated 27/12/2008 and in turn, the concerned respondent is directed to consider his case on its own merits and in its perspective. If the petitioners stand on the same footing as per order passed by the State Administrative Tribunal in
