- From bare perusal of the order it is 3. clear that no prejudice whatsoever will be caused to the petitioner. In this order, the concerned Authority/ Respondent No.3is simply directed to decide the matter in accordance with the directions of the Sub Divisional Officer after giving an opportunity of hearing to all concerned.
- 4. It is open to the petitioner to seek hearing before the concerned authority if he has concern with the matter. With these observations, review application is dismissed as no case for review is made out.
