1. Further to the orders passed by us from time to time, the learned AGP has placed before us a copy of the GR dated 20<sup>th</sup> October 2011 issued by the State Government for the compliance of the order passed by

the Supreme Court on 7/10/2009 so as to enhance the monetary benefits payable to the employees of the subordinate judiciary all over the State of Maharashtra. This petition has been filed seeking directions for implementation of the order passed by the Supreme Court on 7/10/2009 and pursuant to the said directions the GR dated 20/10/2011 has been issued.

2. Hence the petition has served its purpose and no further orders are required to be passed. In case any of the conditions laid down in the GR are not in keeping with the order passed by the Supreme Court on 7/10/2009, the employees may have their remedy before the appropriate forum.

3. Hence the petition is disposed.

At the same time the employees and their union / federation must note that the law laid down by the Supreme Court does not allow them to resort to any form of strike. The Registrar General to issue a circular accordingly and forward to all the subordinate courts.

4. Civil application does not survive and the same stands disposed as such.
