## **P.C.**:

1. This petition challenges the order dated 10<sup>th</sup> August, 2010 passed by the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Saswad closing the evidence of the prosecution without the evidence of the Investigating Officer because the Investigating Officer was not attending to the

Court for a substantially long time. The petitioner is the original complainant. The learned APP states that the proceedings before the trial court now stand adjourned to 17<sup>th</sup> March, 2011 and that the Investigating Officer will remain present on that day before the trial Court for his evidence without fail. He also states that the Investigating Officer could not attend to the trial because of his hospitalisation.
