Seen earlier orders made by this Court releasing the applicant on bail for a limited period for the reasons stated in those orders.

Learned Counsel for the applicant makes a categorical statement that as a last chance he requires further 25 days' extension to continue on bail in order to complete the treatment of his father. There is no adverse report against the applicant pointed out to this Court about the conduct of the applicant during the period in which he was on bail.

Perused the medical certificates and in particular the certificate dated 12.5.2011, issued by RIPC Heart Care Centre which supports the contention advanced by the learned Counsel for the

applicant.

Be that as it may, in the light of the above discussion, strictly as a last chance, the order of bail granted by this Court for a limited period is extended by another 25 days only i.e. from 01.06.2011 to 25.06.2011.

Statement made by the learned Counsel for the applicant that henceforth no application shall be made for such extension is accepted.

Accordingly, applicant shall furnish bail on the same terms and conditions as were stated in the order dated 1.4.2011.

Criminal Application stands disposed of.
