Hence, the following order.

ORDER

- (i) Misc. Criminal Application is allowed.
- (ii) Applicants shall be released on anticipatory bail in Crime No.81/2011 registered with Police Station Panchpaoli for the offence punishable under Sections 498-A, 306 r/w 34 of Indian Penal Code, upon furnishing P.R. Bond in the sum of Rs.500/- (Rupees Five Hundred Only) each with one surety each in like amount.
- (iii) Applicants shall attend the concerned Police Station on every Monday and Thursday till filing of chargesheet.
- (iv) Applicants shall not leave the
 jurisdiction of Nagpur District without permission
 of the trial Court.
- (v) Applicants shall not tamper with the prosecution witnesses.
 - (vi) Bail before the lower Court.
