It appears that the applicants have been charged for the offences punishable under Sections 498-A, 306 r/w 34 of Indian Penal Code on the allegations that applicant No.1 had illicit relations with Raju @ Rajesh s/o Pandurang Chavhan. Said Rajesh has already been released on regular bail who appears to be the main accused. Merely because applicant No.1 had allegedly illicit relations, it is not possible to jump to a conclusion about her committing the said offences. Hence, this is a fit case for grant of anticipatory bail. Hence, the following order.

O R D E R

(i) Misc. Criminal Application is allowed.

(ii) Applicants shall be released on anticipatory bail in Crime No.81/2011 registered with Police Station Panchpaoli for the offence punishable under Sections 498-A, 306 r/w 34 of Indian Penal Code, upon furnishing P.R. Bond in the sum of Rs.500/- (Rupees Five Hundred Only) each with one surety each in like amount.

(iii) Applicants shall attend the concerned Police Station on every Monday and Thursday till filing of chargesheet.

(iv) Applicants shall not leave the jurisdiction of Nagpur District without permission of the trial Court.

(v) Applicants shall not tamper with the prosecution witnesses.

(vi) Bail before the lower Court.
