The petitioner claims the benefit of ad hoc service followed by regular service for the purpose of pension and increments. According to the petitioner, the issue is covered in his favour by the judgment of this Court rendered in ***LPA 36 of 2010, Sita Ram versus State of H.P. & others***. It is for the respondents to examine the matter. The petitioner submits that he would file appropriate representation furnishing all factual details before the competent authority within a period of ten days from today. It is always open for him to do so. As and when the same is filed, the second respondent shall look into the matter and take appropriate action thereon within a period of four months from the date of the production of copy of this judgment along with a copy of the writ petition and the copy of the judgment referred to above.

2. The writ petition is disposed of, so also the pending application (s), if any.
